# Overview

# On the subject

After intensive negotiations of almost one year, finally an agreement has been reached on the future relationship between Europe and the UK.

Among other things, the agreement on future relations with the UK creates a broad economic partnership, which is based on a free trade agreement without tariffs and quotas and thus averts any major trade barriers.

However, there will be regulatory / legal changes – also for the medtech industry, whose export quota is around 65 percent (almost 5 percent goes to the exporting country Great Britain).

What does the successful conclusion of the negotiations now mean for the medtech industry? To support the industry, the Brexit webinar will provide information on the final agreement and what has been changed from 1 January 2021.

Among others the following questions will be addressed:

- > Under what rules and until when is the new UKCA marking needed to be applied?
- > What is (legally) new with regard to UK notified bodies?
- > What are the tasks and responsibilities of the UK responsible person?
- > What does the transition period for registering medical devices under the MHRA look like?
- > What (legal) changes can be expected with regard to the registration of medical devices in the UK?
