Topic

In order to work as a medical device advisor (MDA) and inform healthcare professionals about or instruct them in the proper handling of medical devices, it is necessary to have and be able to demonstrate the necessary expertise, see § 83 MPDG. The training provides the necessary basic knowledge independent of the product and company. This includes the presentation of the rights, tasks and duties of the MDA, in each case based on the legal requirements resulting in particular from the MDR and the MPDG.

The European and national legal frameworks that apply to medical devices are explained. Participants will learn about several requirements like placing medical devices on the market, the classification and labeling of a medical device or market surveillance and vigilance activites. Furthermore, knowledge of operator law and compliance-compliant behavior in the event of feedback from the market are part of this seminar. A comprehensive understanding of all of the above is essential for adhering to the obligations and requirements of the MDA.

Targetgroup

The seminar is intended for all employees of medical device manufacturers and other economic operators (e.g. distributors) who provide technical information about medical devices and instruct professionals in the handling of medical devices. It is suitable both for new entrants to the profession and for updating and refreshing existing knowledge.
